Prefer temps >21°C

# TWO DISTINCT PREVENTION STRATEGIES



### **FOCUS ON YOUR EXTERIOR**

- Properly cover garbage and store away from
- Eliminate standing water
- Regularly clean up grass clippings, animal droppings and other organic material
- Reduce attractants (external lighting & odors)



## **CREATE A BARRIER**

- Keep doors & windows closed
- Use screens on windows
- · Use air-curtains, plastic strips, etc. on frequently used entrances
- Create positive air pressure within the facility



### STOP THEM AT THE DOOR

- Inspect & reject incoming goods with signs of small
- Store perishables in closed plastic tubs



### **FOCUS ON MOIST ENVIRONMENTS**

- Regularly clean drains & kitchen floors especially underneath equipment
- Eliminate standing water & accumulated condensation
- · Repair flooring to eliminate cracks and crevices
- Repair plumbing & drain problems immediately
- · Clean rags and mop heads before storing
